1. JPPS-Bialik Financial Accessibility Program

JPPS-Bialik is part of a network of schools affiliated with an arms-length organization called Apple Financial Services (AFS). This organization provides a confidential analysis of a family's financial ability to contribute towards the school's tuition fees. A school committee then uses a JPPS-Bialik Board-approved evaluation grid, as well as the AFS analysis in recommending the family's tuition fees, while keeping within the budget constraints of the school's Tuition Assistance funds.

- 2. Families are asked to apply online, directly with the AFS organization (click on: www.applefinancialservices.ca and select the school year 2019-2020). The instructions are on the website and can be easily be followed. It is possible that you will be asked to submit information that was previously submitted. It is important that you follow the instructions properly and submit the information that is requested. It is not necessary to have your most recent tax return completed for this application. AFS accepts estimates that are then validated at a later date. Please do not wait to make your application. There is a small application fee that has to be paid. The only form of payment which is accepted is CREDIT CARD. If you do not have a credit card, it is suggested that you purchase a loadable cash card at a pharmacy, grocery store or Bureau en Gros. This will be needed in order to complete the application.
